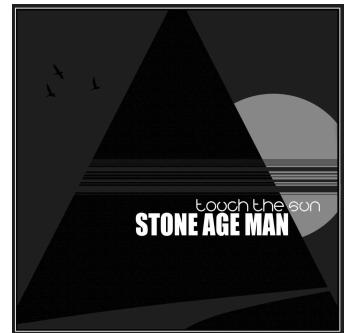
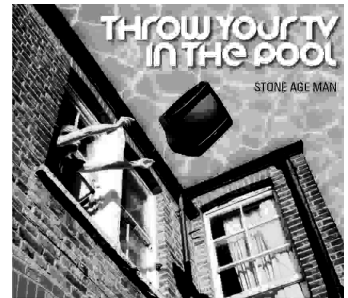

## **Background information:**

Greg Paul Stone is an in demand live performer based in Ottawa/Gatineau who performs between 150-200 live shows per year with many and varied groups including **Stone Age Man**.

Greg Paul Stone left his role as Director of Music at an Australian High School in 2009 to come to Canada with his family and return to composing and performing music. Literally based in a cabin in the woods for the first year and without a working group to write for, the early music from this period is broad in scope with ambitious movements and unexpected twists. After receiving FACTOR funding, this music became the debut **Stone Age Man** EP, *Touch The Sun*.

To realize the songs in a live setting, Greg put together a flexible band of the finest local jazz and rock players to bring **Stone Age Man** to life and show it to the world.

The CrimeTrack



In a typical **Stone Age Man** twist, the same players also perform original instrumental 70's crime music under the pseudonym **The CrimeTrack**.

**The CrimeTrack** combined with Theatre Wakefield and Arts Alive! Québec in October 2015 to present "*Who Loves Ya Baby?: A 1970s Improv in Three Acts*" at The TaDa Festival.

**Stone Age Man** released their latest FACTOR funded EP *Throw Your TV In The Pool* on April 4, 2016.
